4. Functionality of our website, personalization and analytics

2. Accuracy and retention of personal data

We take reasonable and practicable steps to ensure that your personal data is held by us is (i) accurate with regard to the purposes for which it is to be used and (ii) not kept longer than is necessary for the fulfilment of the purpose for which it is to be used.

3. Analytics

When you use our website, we use a third-party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns, for example the number of users. We do this to find out such things as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way that does not directly identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website. We use the information to report on visitor numbers, and to make improvements to our service.

4. Cookies

We collect basic analytics data through cookies when you access or use our website. A "Cookie" is a small piece of data or text file stored on the local hard disk of your computer or mobile device. Cookies allow the website to recognize your device and display our site in accordance with your preferences. Some cookies are only stored temporarily and destroyed each time you close your web browser. Others may remain on your browser and may collect and store data for a period of time after you have left our website. At any time, you can change your browser settings if you don't want us to collect your data by using cookies.

5. Your rights

You can perform your privacy rights by contacting us in free form by email at info@dna.partners.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have seven working days to respond to you. We note that we do not respond to anonymous requests. In case of sending a request, we can ask you to confirm your identity. This is necessary to prevent third parties to deceive access to personal data.
